Guidelines for Timed Racers, updated 10/31/2018:

- 1. Read the information below to know what to expect on race morning.
- 2. Thank the volunteers! They're donating their time to ensure your safety on race morning.
- 3. Have fun and follow the rules!

When can I access the Timed Corral?

- Runners can access the Timed Corral as early as 7:30AM
- The Timed Corral closes at 8:40AM. Runners arriving after 8:40AM will start with the Untimed Corral.
- There are port-o-lets inside the Timed Corral, so there is no need for last minute entry.

Where can I access the Timed Corral?

- There are (3) Timed Runner Corral entries
 - o Gate 1: Located on the NORTH side of Young St. between Ervay and S. Saint Paul
 - o Gate 2: Located on the NORTH side of Young St. between Ervay and S. Saint Paul
 - o Gate 3: Located at St. Paul and Marilla SOUTH of Young St.
- Runners CANNOT access the Timed Corral from Ervay/Young.
- Runners CANNOT access the Timed Corral from Harwood/Young
- Wheelchair racers with appropriate racing wheelchair should enter at the gate nearest Ervay, on the NORTH side of Young Street.

Who can access the Timed Corral?

- As a timed racer you have access to the Timed Corral located east of Ervay.
- Please note that only racers with Timed Corral Bibs will be allowed entry into the Timed Corral.
- If your party has a mix of Timed and Untimed bibs, you can all start together in the Untimed Corral. This includes children and adults.
- There are no strollers or pets allowed in the Timed Corral. If you do have pets or strollers, please begin at the back of the Untimed Corral.
